

Revelation after Egypt

The children of Israel have been delivered from their bondage in Egypt. They have been miraculously provided for in the wilderness. Now, God reveals how to live before Him and with each other by the law that He gives them through Moses on Mount Sinai. Basically God requires supreme devotion to Him and sincere affection for others. In the law is included the Sabbath law, capital punishment laws, spiritual laws, property rights, and the specifications for building and furnishing the tabernacle. God leads the people with a pillar of fire by night and a cloud by day. He is in the midst of them daily. The nation of Israel is centered on God.

Are you Smarter than your Parents?

Objectives: Fun competition between kids and their parents
Gain knowledge about the Exodus of the children of Israel from Egypt
Have fun with your family.

Number of Players: At least one parent and 1 or more kids

Length: 30 minutes - 1 hour

Set up: Set up an area around your dining table or living room where everyone can face each other. Give everyone a pair of spoons that they can bang together to signal when they want to answer the question. Designate one person as the show host. They will be the score keeper, timer keeper and the host who asks the questions (use Mom or Dad for this role).

Rules: You could do this game in two parts--one night listen to the teaching as a family to refresh yourselves on the story--then, on another night, play the game. The Host will begin by explaining the rules. A question will be asked and everyone has 5 seconds to indicate they want to answer the question by banging their spoons together. Then they have 10 seconds to answer the question. If they answer correctly, they receive 5 points. If they don't answer correctly or they don't answer within the 10 seconds, the host will buzz them and then any of the other contestants may indicate they want to answer by banging their spoons together. If no one answers, the host will tell the answer and Dad will lose 1 point. After all of the questions are asked, total the points of each player. Now you have your answer: Are you smarter than your parents. (only the person designated as host should look at the next page with the questions and answers)

| 14 | What was the punishment for killing someone? | They shall be put to death (Ex 21:12) |

| 21 | On what 3 body parts was blood put on Aaron and his sons to consecrate them to the priesthood? | tip of their right ear, thumb of their right hand, big toe of their right foot (Ex 29:20) |
| 22 | Why did Moses break the stone tables | He saw the people dancing before a golden calf (Ex 32:19) |
